Obligations:

- **Fast** – the first Thursday of Rajab
- **Prayers** to offer between Maghrib and 'Isha Prayers –
 - Recite 12 rak'at prayers in sets of two 6 x 2
 - In each rak'at after Surat al-Hamd recite
 - Surat al-Qadr x 3 **إِنَّا أَنْزَلْنَاهُ فِي لَيْلَةِ الْقَدْرِ**
 - Surat al-Ikhlās x 12 **قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ**

- Recite 70 times

■ اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ النَّبِيِّ الْأُمِّيِّ وَعَلَى
آلِهِ (وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ)

- In Sajda – repeat 70 times

يا حنان يا منان

- After Sajda and in a sitting posture
- Recite 70 times

- In Sajda – repeat 70 times
